### **In-House Counsel Conference**

ACCGP’s In-House Counsel Conference is our largest event of the year. The event will be held on April 16, 2026 at the Pennsylvania Convention Center. In 2025, we had nearly 800 attendees and over 30 exhibitors. We will be allowing legal operations and paralegals to join us for the conference and attend the sponsored CLE sessions. This event is open to both law firms and vendors to sponsor. For sponsorships including a marketing table, only two attendees are permitted to attend per company. Sponsor attendees are welcome to attend any of our educational sessions, as well as breakfast, lunch, and cocktail reception.

### Practice Group Roundtable (Non-CLE)

Our Practice Group Roundtables provide a forum for the sponsoring firm to interact with a small group of in-house attorneys for a discussion of a particular practice area. CLE Credits are not offered at these programs to facilitate group discussion. The discussion topics are selected in consultation with the practice group co-chairs. The sponsoring firm can provide input on the time of day (breakfast, lunch or evening) and location (restaurant or at sponsor's office). The sponsor is responsible for paying for the cost of the venue, food and beverage.

### Career Management Committee Programs

### Pro Bono Activity

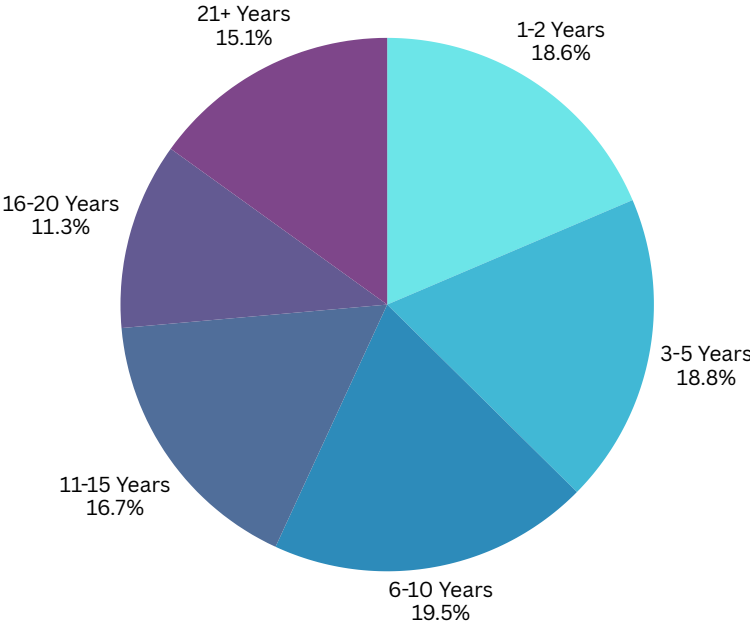
The sponsor will have the opportunity to host a pro bono activity for ACCGP volunteers. The activity does not need to be legal in nature – it can involve some form of community service.

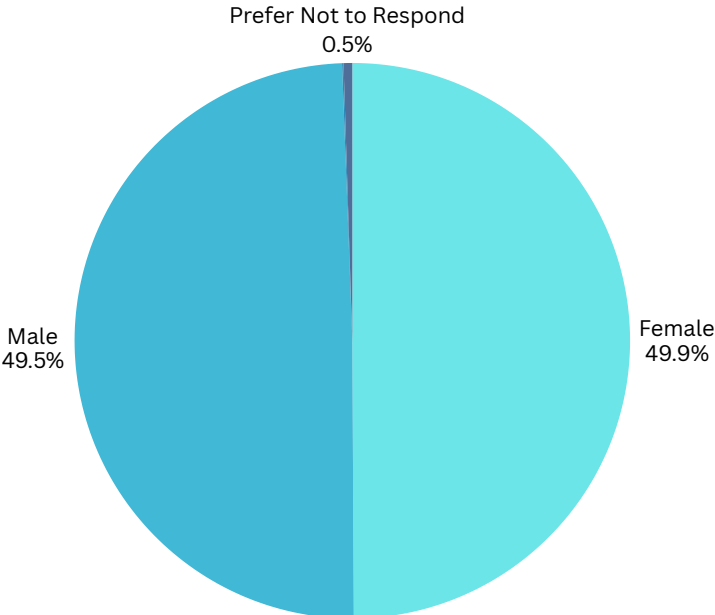


# ACCGP Member Demographics

By Years in House

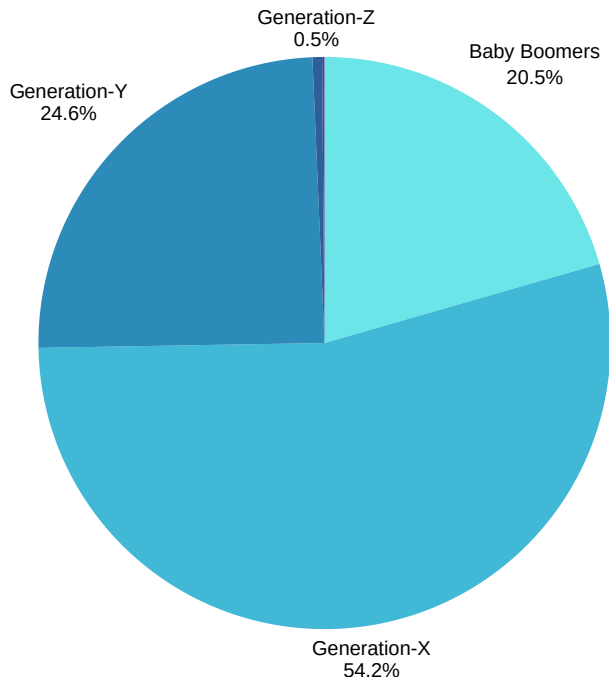


By Gender

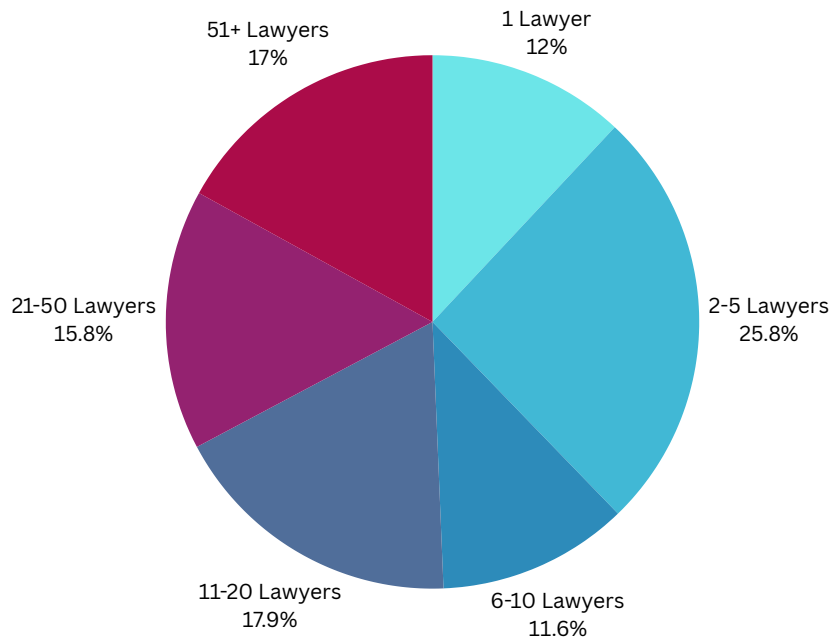




### Generational Diversity

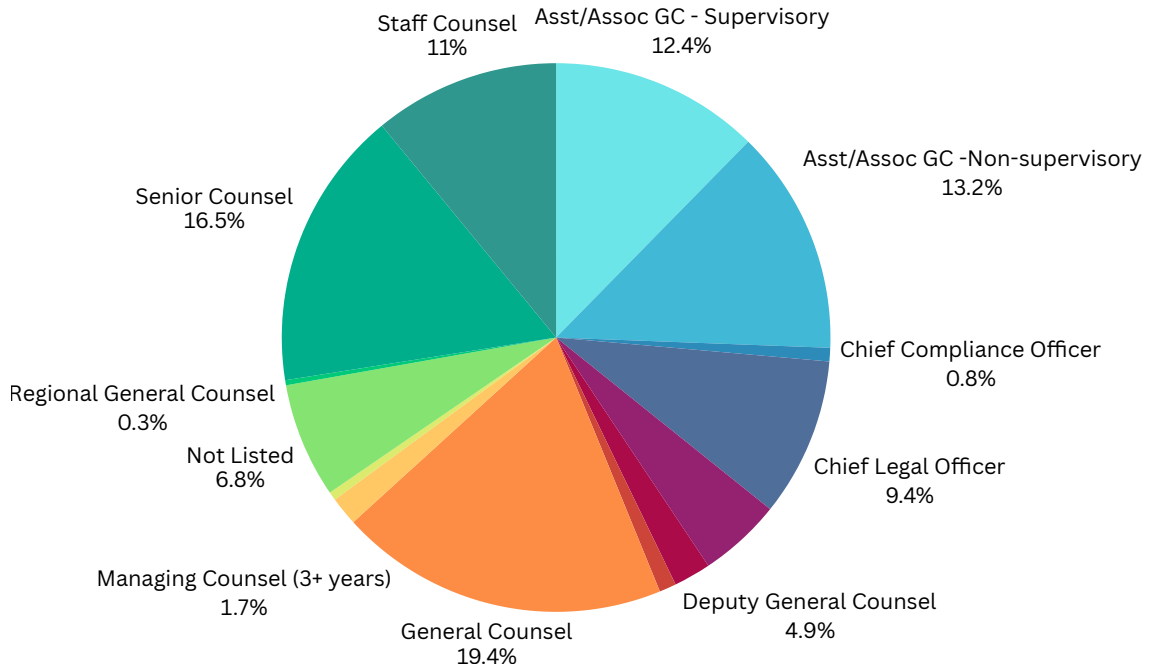


### By Size of Legal Department
